

## *Bulgarian wine from the Valley and the Mountain*

### *The History:*

This tour will combine the south – east Thracian valley and Sakar mountain.

As previously mentioned, the region of the Thracian valley is famous with its wine producing from ancient times.

### *The Wine:*

The south-east Thracian Valley grows typical Bulgarian wine grape varieties as Dimyat, Keratsuda, Tamyanka, Pamid and Mavrud as well as French and German wine varieties as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Aligote, Chardonnay, Riesling, Gewurztraminer etc.

### *The Area:*

The region offers beautiful natural sights of vineyards as well as some cultural sights as the Thracian tomb of Alexandrovo.
